#### **News from Mrs. Shutt**

In English, the class has begun to work on a written research report. The topic for the report is any animal of the student's choice. The overview of the research report assignment was handed out in class today. Class time for the next 2½ weeks will be dedicated to this project; however, it might be necessary for the students to do some work outside of class to meet the deadlines: notecards due May 22; rough draft (in notebooks) due May 24; final report due May 31. This week the class will concentrate on finding sources and making notecards. In Reading, the children are continuing to read the novel, Frindle. Spelling Lesson 32 is due Thursday; the test on the lesson is Friday. Mrs. Shutt was surprised at the number of 5th grade students who did not have the workbook done last week.
